During this difficult year for our community, CSET continued its mission by providing expanded services for those in need while incorporating new safety protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Despite increased demand, CSET was able to provide timely services to customers who needed crucial resources such as stable housing, food assistance, and job placement.

CSET staff met the COVID-19 challenge with determination and compassion. A few examples of their achievements include: our Meals on Wheels team delivered 167,645 nutritious meals to senior citizens, 543 households received utility and housing assistance, and \$5.9 million in tax refunds were brought back to Tulare and Kings County residents through our no-cost tax assistance program. This crucial work was possible through the power of the community and CSET's many partners and supporters.
