James had been working in various temporary jobs for several years when he began the Expanded Subsidized Employment (ESE) program in August 2019. As a single parent, he needed permanent employment with benefits and a schedule that accommodated his children's school and childcare needs. With the support of ESE staff, James attained a temporary driver's license and access to paid work experience, which led to employment with a

company that offers benefits. Moreover, the company also provides a work schedule that allows James to successfully manage his children's school and childcare schedules.
