Recycling center for electronics opens Saturday

People with old computers, TV sets and other electronics equipment — all items hard to get rid of — can take them to a South Mooney Boulevard parking lot Saturday.

E-Recycling Solutions, a project of C-SET, and Electronic Recyclers of Fresno will collect a long list of electronics items. The equipment will be taken to Electronic Recyclers' Fresno facility for recycling.

Electronic Recyclers says it is the largest recycler of electronic waste in California.

State law prohibits getting rid of electronics equipment in any way but through a certified recycling program. Electronics equipment contains toxic elements like lead and mercury that could be an environmental hazard in a landfill.

C-SET is an employment training organization that's part of the Tulare County Office of Education.
