It is anticipated that Cutler Senior Center attendance will gradually reach an average of 400 hot meals per month in 2023, including an additional 600 frozen meals delivered to seniors in the Alta District. Hot lunches are provided to local seniors at the Cutler Senior Center on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays at 11:30 AM. In addition to nutritious meals, seniors are provided with supplemental food, social contact, monitoring of well-being by trained CSET staff, and more.
